Hokotehi Moriori Trust is the Moriori Tribal Authority on Rēkohu (Chatham Islands) and has purchased two farms, a tourist lodge, built a beautiful Marae and secured the allocation fishing quota for Rēkohu from the Treaty sea fisheries settlement. We have over 1,000 registered members and 9 staff members. Restoration of the heritage, identity and culture of Moriori and building the cultural capacity of our people is of fundamental importance to our kaupapa.

We are now seeking to employ a new General Manager for our tribal authority who will be responsible for running HMT's business operations on a day to day basis and in providing management and leadership for our staff. The successful candidate will be expected to demonstrate proven experience in some or all of our focal businesses (farming, nursery, fishing and tourism). Experience in successfully managing business portfolios of assets (over \$10 million) and in employment related matters are considered vital in this job.

Experience living and working in a remote community with the unique challenges that offers, will be an advantage. A competitive remuneration package will be offered to the successful applicant including salary, accommodation, vehicle, relocation allowance (if necessary) and travel allowance.
