# **METRO BUS SERVICE**

CCH is also well serviced by public transport. The #80 to Parklands stops directly outside 301 Tuam St (2nd Bus Stop from bus exchange).

Any bus going to Ara Institute (formally CPIT) will also be a good option. first bus stop from the bus exchange stops outside the public pay & display carpark.

#### Public Pay & Display Carpark (Corner Tuam & Barbadoes Sts)

Participants park in the public pay & display carpark on the corner of Tuam and Barbadoes Sts (entrance off Tuam St heading east as this section of Tuam St is one way until it gets to Barbadoes St). Cost is \$5 per day (correct coin required as vending machine does not give change).

CCH is a short 2 minute walk further down Tuam St past the Service Station.

## **Total Mobility Carparks**

There is one mobility carpark on site and one on the Street which is limited to 60 minutes.
